- Dramatically reduced school time for students
- Reduction in services for students (speech, therapy and other programs)

TRANSPORTATION

- Reduced ability and resources for daily transportation of students; both public and parochial students
- All extra-curricular transportation

STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

- Counseling
- Mental Health Counseling
- Health Services provided through School Nurses

SCHOOL SAFETY RESOURCES
