Dear Parents/Guardians,

All students in grades kindergarten through eighth grade will be completing their final round of MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) benchmark tests for the 2017-18 school year. The MAP benchmark tests serve as a basic indicator if your child is performing below, at, or above grade level in the areas of reading and math. Below you will find a chart that specifies the goal score for reading and math at each respective grade level. We encourage you to talk to your child about the importance of doing his/her best on the tests. We have found that students who have a goal in mind that has been discussed with them tend to put forth more effort leading to a higher possible score.
